Why do we do it?

The Rotary Youth Exchange Program is an educational exchange conducted by Rotary on behalf of the NSW Department of Education & Communities in conjunction with the Education Authority in the exchange country.

The Entry Visa to the Host Country is a **Student Visa** and satisfactory attendance and participation at school is a condition of the visa.

Rotary Youth Exchange is respected all over the world as one of the best and most prestigious programs available to students – IT IS THE GOLD STANDARD.

OBJECTIVES OF THE RYEP

This is why!

To further International goodwill and understanding by enabling students to immerse themselves in the culture and language of another culture.

To enable students to further their education by studying in an environment entirely different to their own and by undertaking study of courses and subjects not normally available to them in secondary schools in their own country.

To broaden the student's own outlook by learning to live with and meet people of cultures, creeds and colours different to their own, and by having to cope with day to day problems in an environment completely different to the one they have experienced at home.

To act as ambassadors for their own country by addressing Rotary Clubs, community organisations and youth groups in their host country and by imparting as much knowledge as they can of their own country and its culture to the people they meet during their year abroad.

To study and observe all facets of life and culture in the country where they are hosted so that on return to their home country they can pass on the knowledge they have gained by addressing Rotary Clubs, youth groups and community organisations.

To promote peace and goodwill between citizens of the world, starting with our youth to create understanding and tolerance between cultures worldwide.
