SATURDAY 14th

Sea Kayaking

Kayaking from our waterfront base, we paddle the inner islands before spending time relaxing and swimming. The waters are home to turtles, dolphins, soaring sea eagles and a myriad of colourful tropical fish.

There is time to trek into nearby hinterlands, lined with ancient grass trees, which attract many varieties of butterflies. All in all, we will spend a beautiful day out on the water. If conditions are favourable, there may be an opportunity to snorkel the fringing coral reef.

SUNDAY 15th

Ocean Rafting

Experience ocean rafting's fuelled action while exploring the islands, inlets and beaches on custom built semi-rigid inflatable vessels, travelling at speeds of up to 30 knots. The vessels are up to 72 metre semi-rigid inflatable vessels, originally designed and built as rescue crafts and are driven by 500hp engines, allowing you to experience a fun, high speed ride amongst the natural beauty. You will also get the opportunity to snorkel.
